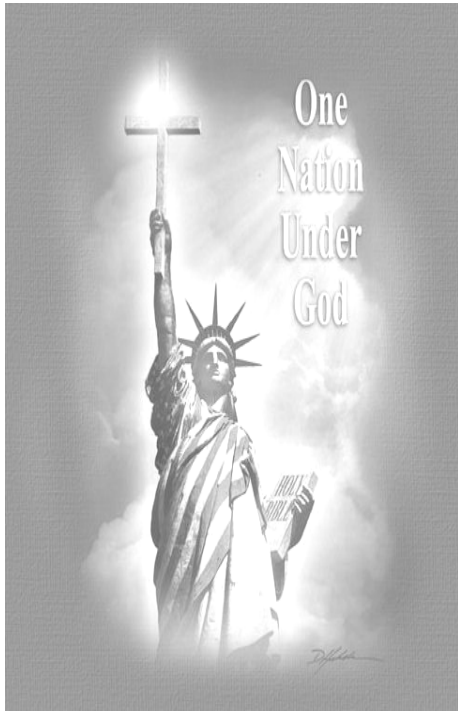

TUNE OUT TV & VIDEO GAMES THIS SUMMER???

Now that school is out for the summer, are you afraid the only thing that will get a workout in your house is the TV? With so many hours to fill each day, it's natural that some kids will want to plop down on the floor or couch for a daily dose of cartoons, movies, and video games. While some TV can be entirely appropriate, too much can quickly turn some kids into "couch potatoes." It's your call on how much TV your kids can watch. However, limiting the time spent in front of the TV generally means kids will put more thought into and be more selective about what they watch. This also frees up their time to get involved in other activities. Here are a few suggestions on how to limit TV time this summer:

Keep the TV off for a whole day. This is a 24-hour test. If your kids don't know what to do with their time, it's a good clue that they are too dependent on television. Ironically, you may find that this test is harder on you than on your kids. One of the best things you can do is replace TV time with less sedentary activities (walking, biking, gardening).

Give your kids other choices. Structuring your children's time lets them enjoy useful, constructive activities instead of wasting hours staring at a TV screen. Television and video games should not be a baby sitter. Schedule time for crafts, sports, exercise, reading, walking, or other activities. The more time your children spend doing constructive activities, the less time they have to watch TV and play video games.
