Last Servers' Training For the Fall

There will be one more training for the young men who would like to serve for the parishes' Masses. The training will be on Monday, July 25 at Immaculate Conception at 6:30pm. As I mentioned before, the connection between serving at the altar and the fostering of priestly vocations has been shown to be a reality. Any of the girls who have already been trained can continue to serve as long as they would like to serve. This adjustment to who will be serving at the Masses is the implementation of the norms for servers at Mass, as established by the Holy Father, the conference of American bishops, and our local archbishop.

Communion Under One Species

The practice of the universal Roman Catholic Church is to receive the Eucharist under only one species. There are a couple of documents which state that it is possible to receive both species. However, in traveling throughout the Church, it becomes obvious that the practice of receiving the Eucharist under both species is not a widespread reality. Early in the Church's history, it was declared that nothing was lacking in receiving the fullness of our Eucharistic Lord, body and blood, soul and divinity, by receiving the Eucharist in the Precious Body only. To think we are somehow "missing out" by not having both species is a faulty understanding of the Eucharistic mystery. After much reflection, thought, and prayer, we will continue to have communion available under only one species.

Nihil obstat & Imprimatur ~ (Latin for "nothing hinders" or "nothing stands in the way"). The phrase is used to mean an "attestation by a church censor that a book (the Bible or another spiritual book) contains nothing damaging to faith or morals". The *nihil obstat* is not a certification that those granting it agree with the contents, opinions or statements expressed in the work; instead, it merely confirms "that it contains nothing contrary to faith or morals." The *nihil obstat* is the first step in having a book published under Church auspices. The final approval is given through the *imprimatur* ("let it be printed") of the author's bishop or of the bishop of the place of publication.
